



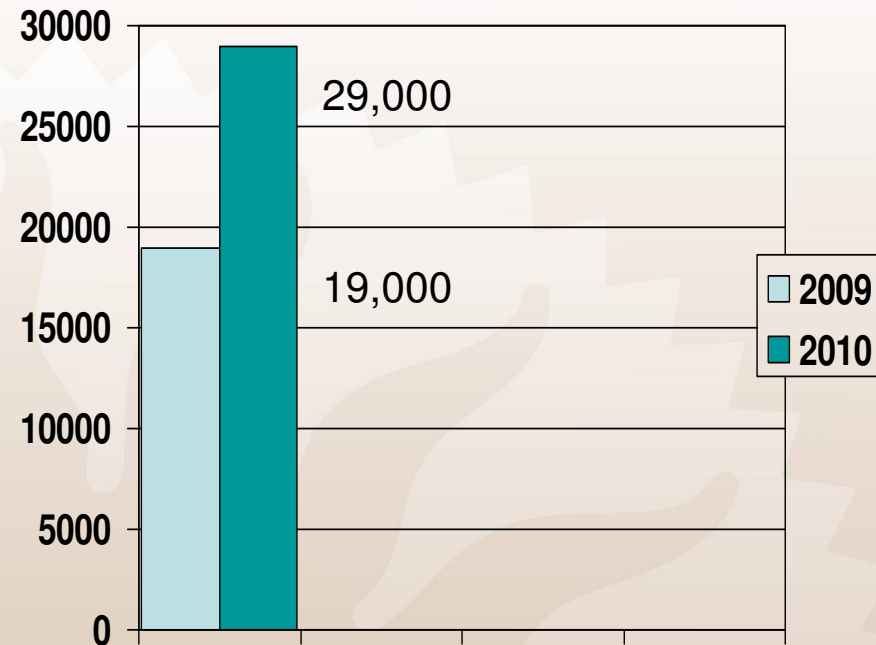

Progress

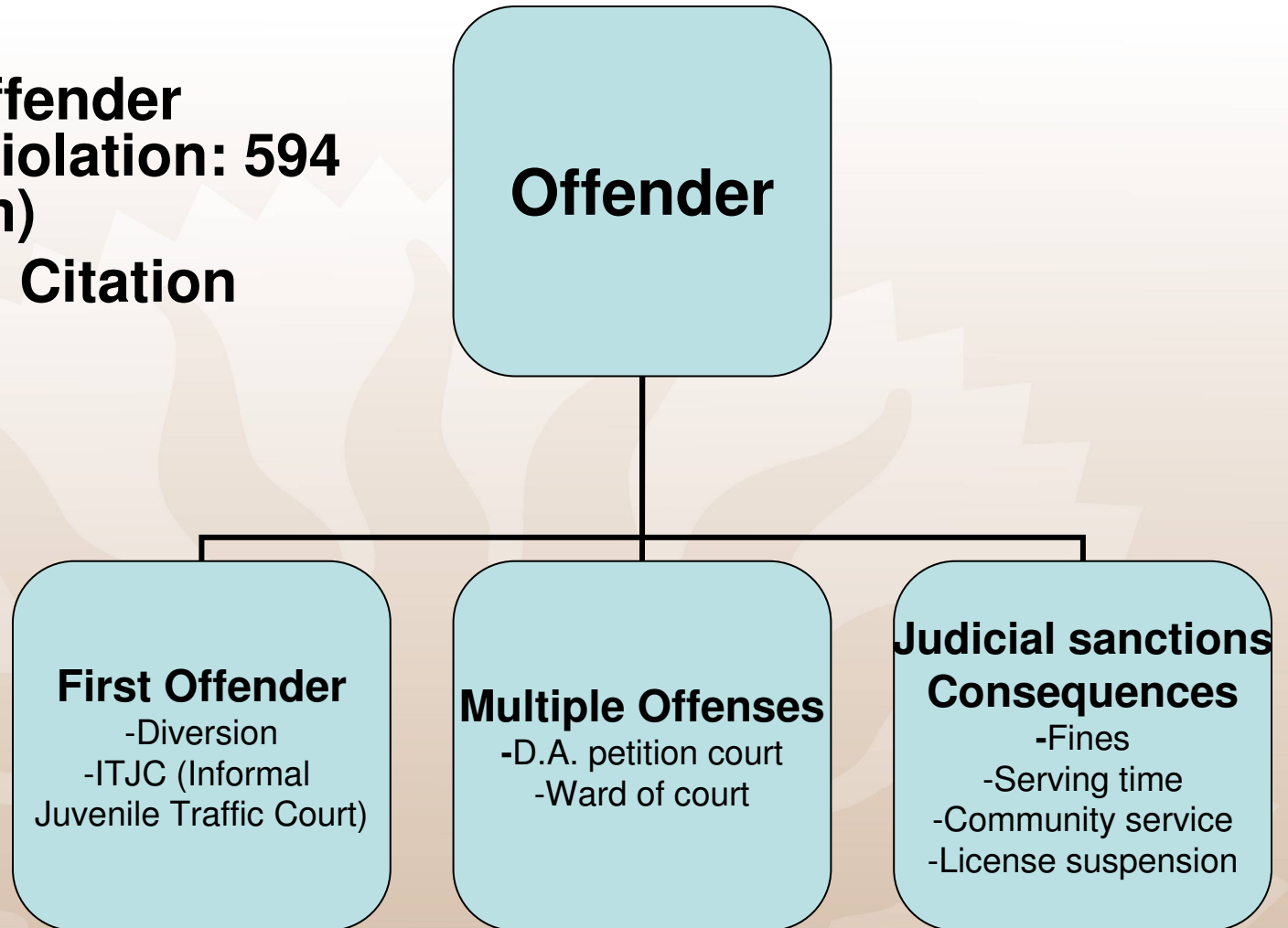
- Greater Sanctions Analysis (CAO, SJPD, PRNS).....11/09
 - Municipal Code vs. Penal Code
- Convene stakeholders group (SJPD, PRNS, Santa Clara County Probation, SAP).....12/09-Present
- Completed the 2010 City Wide Graffiti Survey.....2/10
- Council Member Nguyen briefing update.....2/10
- Presented to MGPTF Inter-Agency Sub-Committee.....4/10

Enhancements/Next Steps

- Complete a “Graffiti Collaborative” work plan
 - Establish report back schedule – (Inter Agency)
- Re-establish/Formalize Agreements (M.O.U.’s)
- Designate Sentencing Alternative Program (SAP) as the clearing house for Graffiti referrals
- Re-Activation of TAG Class
- Maximize Community Resources to remove Graffiti (volunteer pool)
